 (Land No 652) Beginning at a Black Oak standing on  
 the South Side of Hole Cherry River a small Distance above  
 the West end of an Island and Running thence North  
 forty two poles Crossing the River <sup>and passing by</sup> a Marked Black  
 Walnut Tree and then to a Marked White Oak Tree and  
 thence South three Hundred and Ninety two  
 Poles and passing over Cherry Creek to a Stake  
 Thence South three Hundred and five Poles Crossing  
 the sd River to a Stake standing on the bank thereof  
 Thence with the different Meanders thence to the  
 Place of Beginning containing six Hundred and five  
 =ly Acres of Land - Located by a seat given to John  
 Inck - W - Moody & Jacob Casner & Henry Casner
